- 1 For the best results use high gloss photo paper in a color printer.  
SET YOUR PRINTER TO PHOTO QUALITY and select GLOSSY PHOTO PAPER
- 2 this is intended to fit nicely into an 8 x 10 standard photo frame
- 3 the instore bio is set up for a standard 8.5 x 11 page so it will be easy for you to print, but might require a little trim to fit into your frame.
- 4 you can easily scale this document smaller by changing the output settings on your printer. I have left lots of white space at the edges so you can have freedom to adjust the size to fit your needs.
- 5 do NOT increase the size of this document.. you will loose image quality.
